

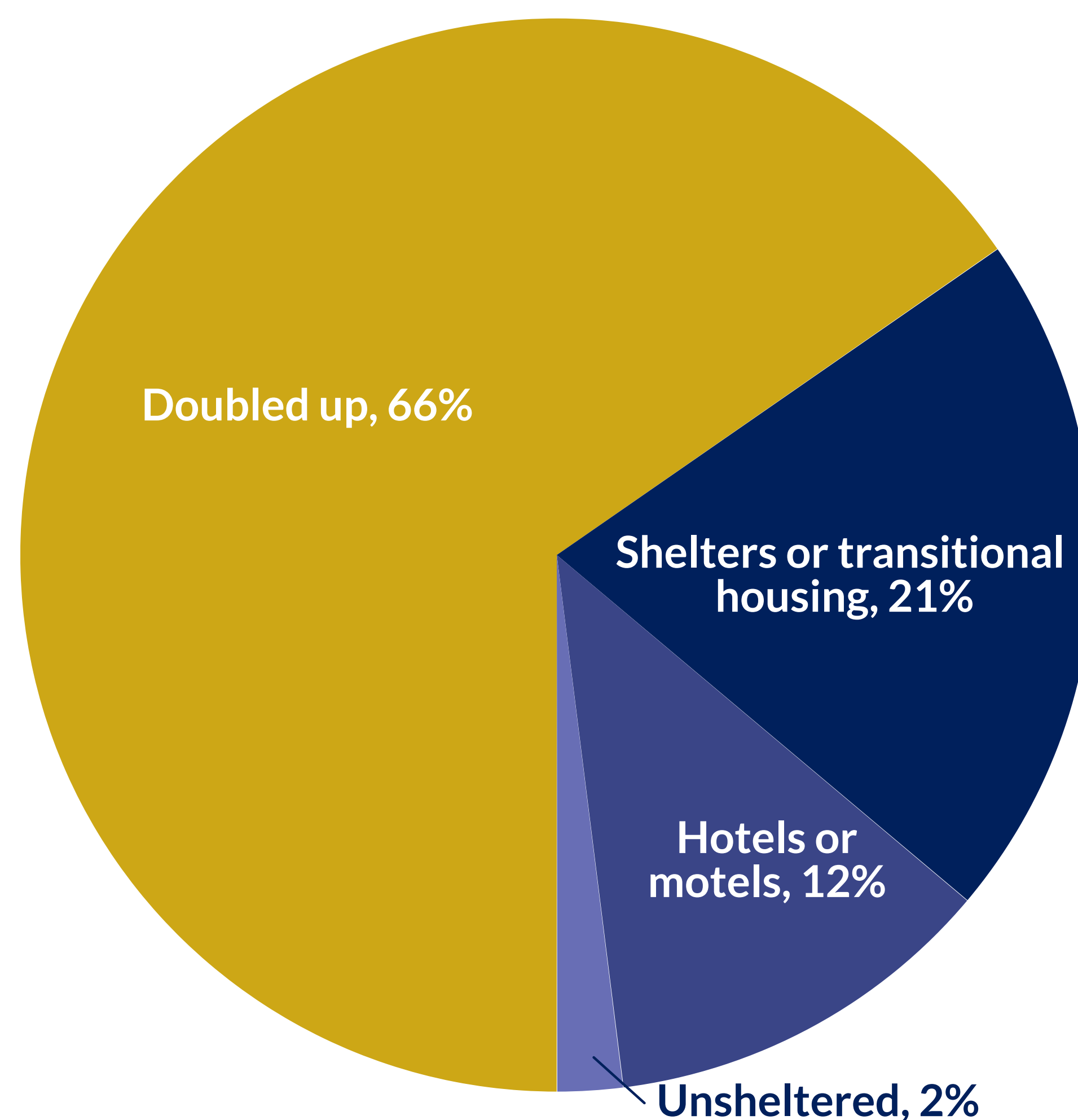
2021-22 Education for Children and Youth Experiencing Homelessness (ECYEH)

40,003

children and youth experiencing homelessness in Pennsylvania
July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022

- 85%** of identified children and youth were enrolled in school
- 15%** of identified children and youth were ages 0-5 not yet enrolled in kindergarten
- 11%** of identified children and youth were unaccompanied

Nighttime Status (enrolled)
determines an individual's homelessness status



Enrolled children and youth experiencing homelessness made up approximately 2% of PA's public school population

ECYEH Snapshot

- 25%** of children and youth identified as having a disability
- 10%** of children and youth identified as being an English Learner
- 3%** of children and youth identified as being migrant
- 17%** of enrolled students experienced barriers to school enrollment, attendance, or academic success
- 79%** of enrolled students remained in their school of origin
- 66%** Grade 12 Graduation rate
- 7%** Grade 12 Dropout rate

ECYEH Program Outcomes and Impact

- 42%** of students enrolled in school for 10+ days had a 90% attendance rate
- 4%** of students in Grades 7-12 dropped out of school
- 27%** of students assessed scored proficient or advanced levels on state literacy assessments in 2021
- 11%** of students assessed scored proficient or advanced levels on state math assessments in 2021
- 748** LEAs, shelters, pre-K programs, and agencies received direct ECYEH services
- 80%** of identified children and youth received services at the individual level
