AHCCS Gifted Program Identification & Underrepresented Student Populations' Procedure (2025-2026)

- For students who meet the definition of the "underrepresented student populations", and score at the equivalent of the 90th percentile and/or above, will be referred for a Gifted Education Evaluation. (National Association for Gifted Children, n.d.)
- Referrals for the Gifted Program Identification include any of the following:
 - Teacher/Staff Referral
 - CDT and/or IXL Diagnostic Testing Screening
 - (blue score range OR the green score range for underrepresented student populations only.)

Definitions:

Underrepresented Student Populations: Those who exhibit at least one of the following factors: Limited English proficient, English as a second language, learning disability, physical impairment, emotional disability, gender bias, racial-, linguistic- or ethnic-minority background, and/or socio/cultural deprivation (National Association for Gifted Children, n.d.).
